Wastewater/Water Technician

Description of Work:

Employees will perform a variety of skilled, semi-skilled and unskilled labor tasks in the maintenance, operation, and repair of water and sewer lines and appurtenances, Grade 2 Biological Wastewater Treatment Plant, and sewer lift stations. Work involves operating a variety of tools and equipment to repair and replace sections of water and sewer lines and pumps as well as operating and maintaining the wastewater treatment plant. Work includes mowing grass, spraying, etc. to maintain right of ways and grounds surrounding treatment plant and lift stations. Employees are also subject to on-call and call-back work.

Minimum Training and Experience Requirements:

Graduation from high school and some experience in semi-skilled maintenance or construction work which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

- Possession and maintenance of a valid North Carolina driver's license
- Willingness and ability to successfully obtain the required grade level water distribution certification required by the State for the County's water system
